## Kōrakonui School Fundraiser **Beats by Bingo Night**

#### It's Bingo time!

Kōrakonui School is hosting a 'Beats by Bingo' night on Friday 10th March, 2023. Our 'Beats by Bingo' fundraiser is to raise funds to cover our muchneeded pool refurbishment. Our pool had severe leaks, damaged plumbing, and an outdated filtering system that didn't meet the standards required for a pool of its size.



Confidence and safety in and around the water is vital for our children. Students at Kōrakonui School swim daily during Term one and four. The pool is a community resource and is open to locals over the summer period, so families can make use of and enjoy this resource. whilst supporting children to continually develop their water confidence and skills. Between the school children and the Kōrakonui community, the pool gets a lot of use!

We have raised \$39,170 so far and called upon our local community to provide labour and resources to cut costs. Our 'Beats by Bingo' fundraiser aims to help us raise some of the remaining \$21,966 needed to cover the cost of the pool refurbishment.
